Attached is a copy of a portion of the January 17, 2023, presentation by Bartle-Wells. Please note I have added some numbers to show the impact relating to a bi-monthly cost to the ratepayers. Please note that the cost has doubled (Page 16) by 2027. If the other water district's do not start a Prop-218, we will be the most expensive water district in the area.

If we look at the big picture for the District, this Prop-218 is only a very small percentage of the overall needs to complete the actual improvements needed. Looking at this Prop-218, I estimate it to be about 10% -15% of the overall improvements needed for the District. If you do the math, the cost of survival is off the charts.

We need to put more attention to Plan B (Combining with SSWD).




