IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL PERMIT FEE, CHARGES WILL BE BASED UPON THE INDICATED SCHEDULE AS DETERMINED BY DEL PASO MANOR WATER DISTRICT (DPMWD) PER ORDINANCE No.3, ARTICLE 9:

A load log will be required and will be billed at the *rate of \$_____ per each 100 cubic feet (748 gallons). All tanks shall be equipped with air gap or other approved backflow device. Monthly totals must be submitted in writing by the 15th of each month; the complete log is due at end of the project.

() SCHEDULE "B" - Meter Use

There will be a \$120.00 per meter charge for installing and removing a temporary meter to a hydrant which is due at time of permit application. Each additional hydrant move will have a \$60.00 charge due when the change request is made. A refundable deposit of \$875.00 for the meter will be required at time of permit application. Usage will be charged at a *rate of \$_____ per each 100 cubic feet (748 gallons) which will be billed at the end of the project.

TERMS: Billed charges due 30 days from date of bill. Deposits will be refunded once final payment is received. The MINIMUM BILLING CHARGE IS \$17.30. *Rates per DPMWD Ordinance No.3, Article 9.

Additional permits will not be granted to firms/persons who have past due invoice outstanding. Failure to remit payment may result in delays in obtaining final sign-off of project and/or legal action.

APPLICANT AGREES TO COMPLY WITH THE GENERAL CONDITIONS REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH ON PAGE 2 OF THIS APPLICATION.

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR HYDRANT USE:

1. In the event that water requirements change during the project construction for which this permit is issued, applicant is obligated to request modification of the permit.
2. Valves must be opened and closed SLOWLY
 - a. Tanker truck permit holders: use approved fire hydrant wrench only for hydrants and caps. Hydrant caps must be placed snugly on hydrants when hydrant is not in use.
 - b. Meter users: open and close the 2-1/2" gate valve slowly for flow control.
(If approved to install and remove the assembly each day, slowly operate hydrant valve fully using an approved hydrant wrench and snugly attach hydrant cap.)
3. Report any damage, theft, leaks or malfunctions to the DPMWD immediately.
4. Permit holder shall, by acceptance and use of this permit, be responsible for any damages to fire hydrant(s), appurtenances and meter assembly, as a result of the use herein authorized, be held responsible for the cost of its repairs, and agrees to pay such costs as soon as the amount thereof is known.
5. The Permit holder shall defend, indemnify and hold DPMWD, its officers and employees, harmless from and against, all claims and/or liabilities for injury to person or persons, or damage to property arising out of the exercise of the permission herein given.
6. The Permit holder shall cease using water at any time upon request of DPMWD or its employees.
7. The Permit must, at all times, be carried in the vehicle drawing water for inspection by DPMWD, fire department and sheriff's department.
8. Upon completion of job: "Tank" applicants report water use using the format below and promptly return to the water district; "Meter" applicants, please notify DPMWD of job completion.
9. This Permit may be revoked at any time.

CONDITIONS FOR USE OF FIRE HYDRANT with METER AND BACKFLOW ASSEMBLY:

- See page 2 of original Permit for general conditions.
- Use of DPMWD assigned fire hydrant without meter and backflow or use of any other hydrant will be in violation of this permit.
- Use only standard fire hydrant tools** for operation of hydrant valve and the install/de-install of meter and backflow assembly. After install of assembly at the start of each day, open hydrant valve slowly and fully then use the 2-1/2" gate valve for flow control. When removing the assembly at the end of each day, slowly close hydrant valve fully using a standard hydrant wrench **(a pipe wrench or any other tool is not permitted)**.
- The Permit Holder shall be responsible for all costs incurred for damages which may occur to hydrant or assembly as a result of their operation or theft. Report theft or damage immediately.
- Final billing for hydrant usage and any associated charges will be submitted for payment per the TERMS section of original agreement. Failure to remit payment may result delays in obtaining Final Sign-off of project and/or legal action.
